STUDENT LEADER SCHOLARSHIP
APPLICATION**

Purpose: The Colorado College Alumni Association Board (AAB) seeks to recognize the efforts of student leaders by offering a *loan-reducing* scholarship to eligible students. The AAB is cognizant of the fact that very often active students on campus become leaders in the alumni association as well. The intent of this scholarship is to encourage students to continue their involvement with CC after graduation through such activities as: attending regional alumni events; recruiting prospective students; being a member of, and even using, the career referral network; and financially supporting the college.

Scholarship: The recipient(s) must be eligible to receive financial aid. It is intended that the scholarship be used to replace a portion of the loans the recipient would otherwise have been given, so as to reduce the student's total debt at graduation. **The scholarship is to be awarded to either a sophomore for use in the recipient's junior year, and/or a junior for use in the recipient's senior year.**

To apply for this AAB scholarship, please submit:

(1) A resume outlining your current extra-curricular activities on and off campus.

(2) A short essay addressing these topics:

(a) \$1 million is a lot of money but can be spent quickly. If you had \$1 million to donate to CC, what would you want the college to do with the money? Would you want it to go to scholarships? Library resources? New facilities? Research funds? Financial Aid? Community service programs? Other areas? Take this opportunity to describe what program(s) would benefit from your generosity and the impact this gift would have on the student body and campus in general.

(b) Alumni participation is important to Colorado College and the Alumni Association Board. Discuss how you, in the five years after graduation, will stay engaged with CC, and can encourage your classmates to do the same.
