We encourage you and/or other leaders in your organization to apply for this *loan-reducing* grant for the 2009-10 academic year. (**You do need to be a sophomore or junior on financial aid to apply.**) The scholarship program is our way of recognizing your service to the college while a student and encouraging you to continue that involvement after you graduate.

When we were students, many of us on the Alumni Association Board (AAB) were members of CCSGA, Student/ Alumni Association, Cutler Publications, DIALogue, Greek organizations, and BSU to name just a few student groups. We know first hand how being involved on campus as a student can predict future involvement in alumni activities. It is our goal to encourage you to stay actively involved with CC long after you graduate.

The 27,000 CC alumni live and work in all 50 states and in more than 80 countries outside the U.S. The college's alumni program promotes alumni involvement in the life of the college through events and community service activities, support for the admission, fundraising and career center programs, and the recognition of outstanding alumni. The AAB works to alert current students to opportunities they will have to become active participants in alumni activities. The Alumni Association Student Leader Scholarship allows us to recognize students who already contribute to the larger CC community and have the potential to become future Alumni Association leaders.
