Selig Fund for Global Study Grant Application

Overview:

The Selig Fund for Global Study is intended to help further the international education of Colorado College students by providing up to \$1200 to help fund the study abroad experience. The scholarship is intended to cover incidental, non-tuition costs associated with study abroad, such as independent travel inquiry, or housing. It may be used towards semester or year-long study abroad programs; it is not applicable for blocks abroad or domestic programs. These awards have been made possible by generous donors to Colorado College who believe in the importance of international study.

Eligibility:

1. Students must be participating in a Colorado College affiliated or approved program abroad. Students participating in off-campus programs in the U.S. are not eligible for this support.
2. Students should have confirmed their study abroad program with the Registrar's Office prior to applying for the Selig fund.
3. Financial need is only one of the components that is considered; it is not required that you be on financial aid currently to apply for this scholarship.

Award Recipients:

Recipients of Selig Fund awards will receive a check from the University for the approved amount. Please be aware that this award may be taxable. Recipients will also be required to submit a letter of appreciation to the donor while abroad or upon their return.
