7. Provide a copy of your most recent resume or c.v.

9. If the funds are to be used for travel, provide a detailed itinerary that includes dates and locations for the duration of the project.

Proposals are due by the end of the second week of block 7. Submit three copies of both this cover sheet and your proposal to the office in the Interdisciplinary House, 1115 N Cascade. The prize will be awarded at the Honors Convocation held in block 8.
