## I.I Long Range Development Plan

Discussion centered on the objective that the LRDP must look both outward and inward in order to define a set of planning questions for the future physical development of the College

Overall, the LRDP should define separate Campus Precincts. Each Precinct should accommodate focused planning and development studies and serve as the framework for the LRDP document

In addition, the LRDP should formally address those items <u>not</u> included or being followed in the 1995 Thompson and Rose Plan

#### 1.2 <u>LRDP Oversight Committees/ Constituency Involvement</u>

Discussed the potential structure and role of two (2) LRDP project oversight committees. One committee would be "Steering" and the other "Advisory." Committee responsibilities and membership rosters to be developed by CC with ISD assistance

It was agreed that a "bottom-up" process that engaged the "Campus Community" (College, City and Neighborhood stakeholders) in the planning effort was important in order to build project awareness, input, etc.

CC requested that a draft of the LRDP committee rosters be prepared for review and comment. Final personnel selection pending College input and President and Trustee approvals

#### 1.3 LRDP / Facility Programming Consultant No Action

CC has retained Jonathan Bergman as facility programming consultant to the College. ISD will work closely with Jonathan to incorporate programmatic needs in with the LRDP

#### LRDP / Consultants 1.4

CC expressed interest in retaining Carl Walker Parking Consultants and Leigh Whitehead Associates as parking and civil engineering consultants to the LRDP team. Actual scopes of work, fees, and additional project subconsultants will be determined later during the preparation of the LRDP proposal

#### 1.5 LRDP Schedule

CC requested a general project schedule be developed indicating key decision points. It was discussed that a full LRDP process could take 2-years to complete. However, ISD believes that a focused effort over the next six to eight months would yield both the "Big Picture/ Vision" for the LRDP as well as identification of general sites for potential new campus buildings or additions
