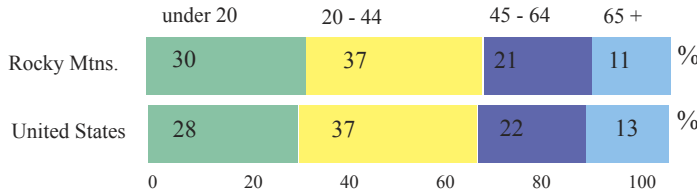

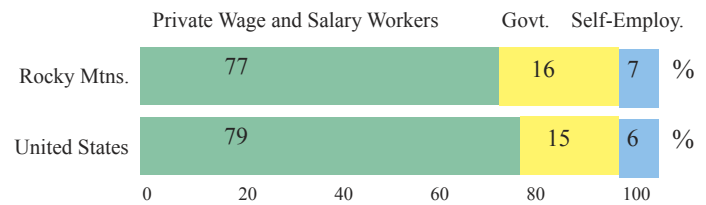

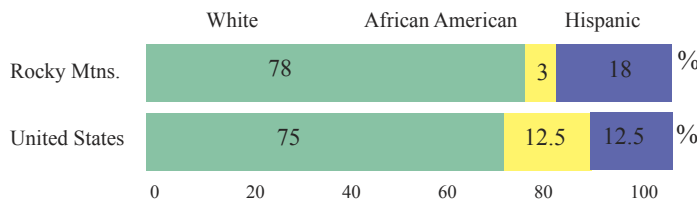

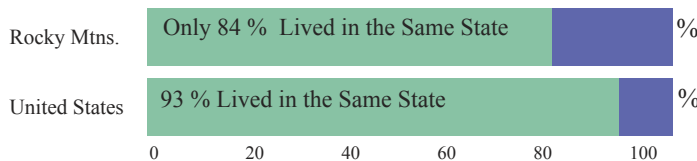

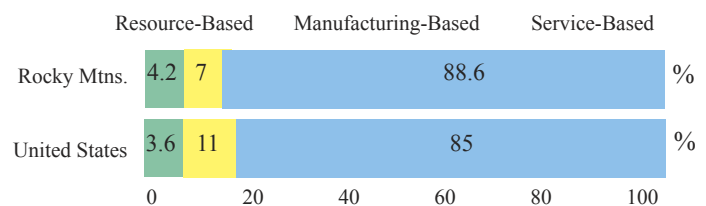

## STATE OF RESIDENCE IN 2000 SAME AS IN 1995

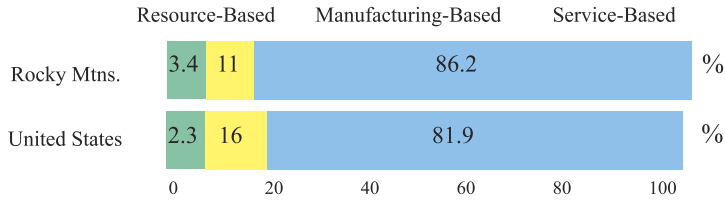

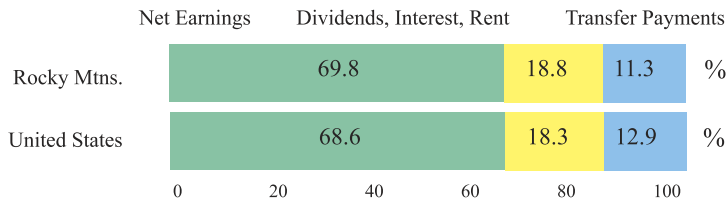

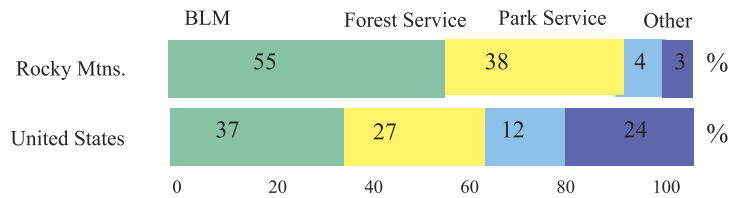

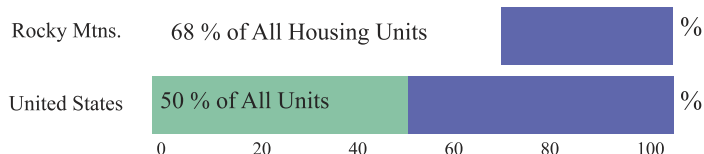
### BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS BY EMPLOYMENT SIZE

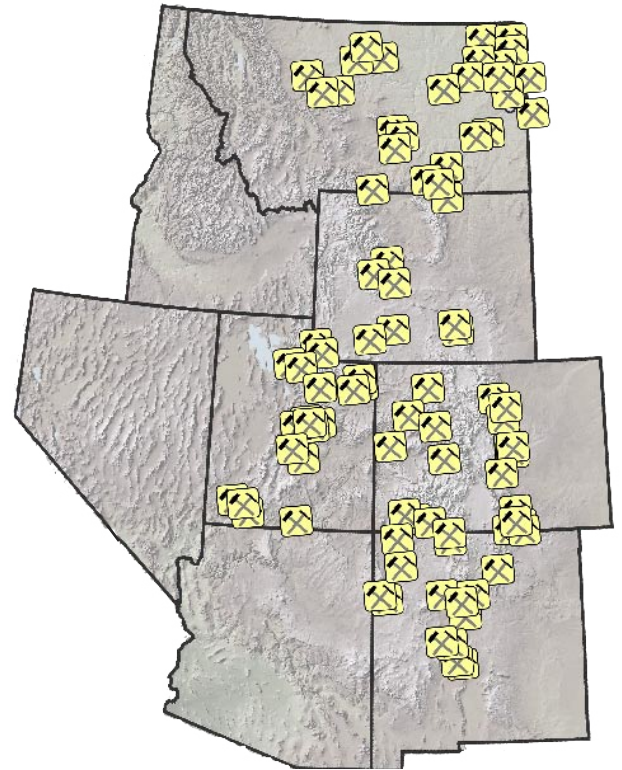
### HOUSING UNITS BUILT BETWEEN 1970 - 2000



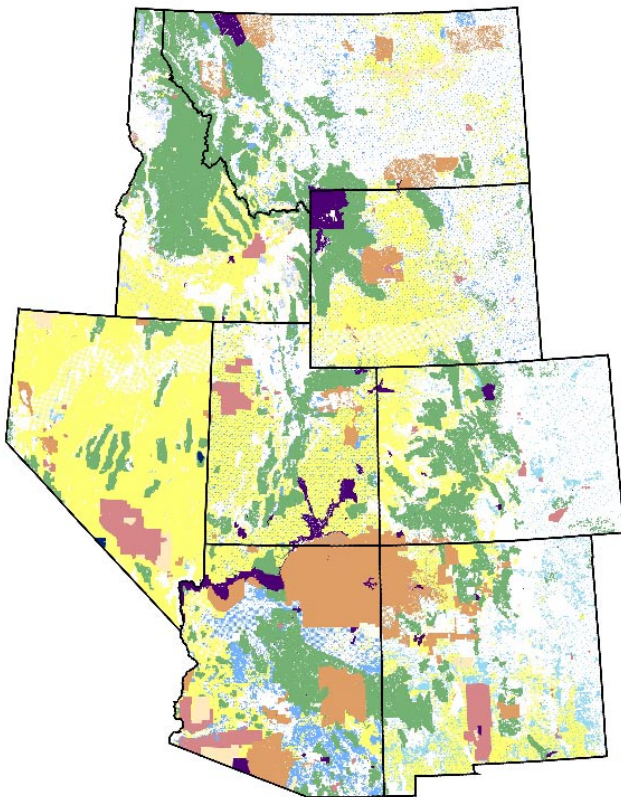

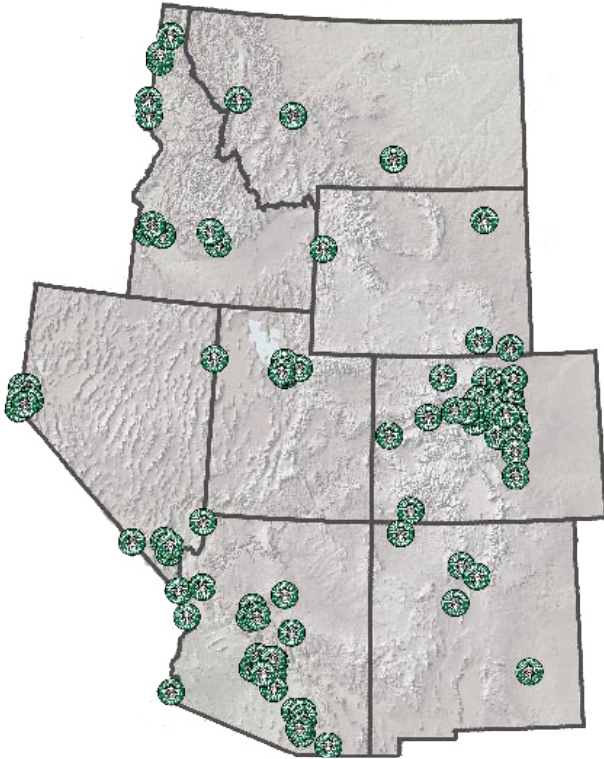

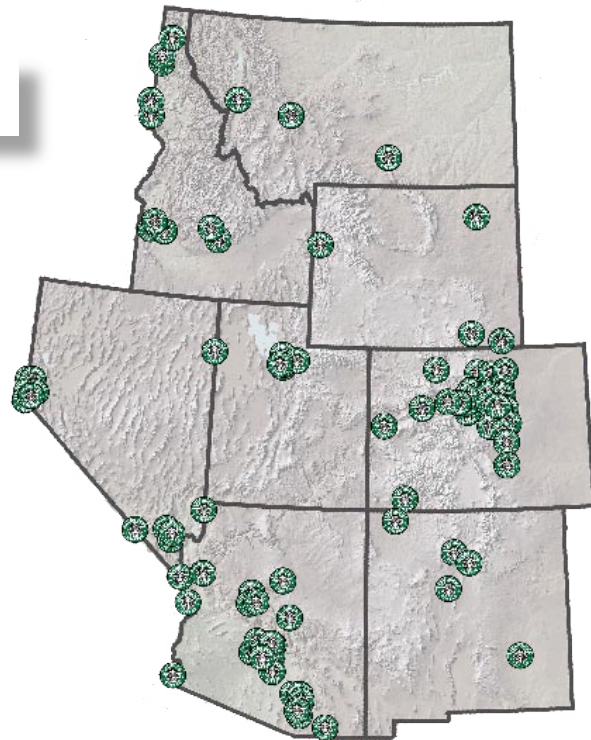
