The Colorado College Education Department has limited financial assistance in the form of a Tuition Fee Waiver or Internship Salary. If you want to be given priority for this assistance, you must submit this application to the Financial Aid Office by FEBRUARY 15, 2007.

If you submit this application after that date or if it is incomplete, you may not be considered for the CC Education Department’s financial assistance. You are also required to file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and submit signed copies of your (and if married, your spouse’s) 2006 federal income tax forms and W-2s by the priority deadline of 2/15/2007. If you file the FAFSA after the priority deadline, you will still be considered for federal aid but you will not be considered for assistance from the CC Education Department. (Refer to the “Financial Aid Application and Timeline” for priority deadlines.)
