Web Time-Entry

Guests expressed concerns about:

- Significant variation between paychecks; don't feel it has been sufficiently communicated how much paychecks will vary; Mandy has found her "dummy" paychecks from the pilot group vary as much as \$100-300.
- Hard to get supervisor approval if you work in an academic department; professors are frequently doing field work or gone for the summer
- If this starts in September, employees will be overpaid for July and August – how will the college reconcile this?
- What about employees who start August 21st – will they get paid for one day of work on their first paycheck?
- Suggested they consider running the pilot program for a full year

Staff Council decided to send a message to Barbara Wilson and Pam Butler expressing these concerns and following up, and also suggesting that open forums be held to provide opportunities for the campus to get questions answered

Ultimately it was decided that this issue warranted a special meeting to address these concerns before 9-month employees leave for the summer, and that we would invite Barbara and others to a special meeting to address these concerns

Mentor Program

- Feedback on flyer was very positive
- Patti will get in touch with Barbara to discuss when this will be implemented.

New Staff Council Members

- We will invite new members to join us for upcoming meetings
- Outgoing members will remain on council until May 31st
- We will have a Hello/Goodbye reception on May 25th; Kristi will arrange location
- Laura Horn will be moving, and thus vacating her Staff Council position;
- A motion was made to ask Daryll Stevens to replace Laura as the next highest vote-getter; motion passed

Parking

- Cindy Tappan at the library volunteered to help coordinate carpooling on campus; Kristi and Courtney will pass this along to the Parking Committee
- Can parking fee be split and deducted from two paychecks for those who carpool?
- Chad will draft responses to the messages Staff Council has received in response to our FLASH message regarding parking

Committee Volunteers

- Staff Council discussed and voted on recommendations for staff openings on campus committees
- Recommendations will be communicated to the president by the co-chairs
- We don't have enough volunteers for the anti-discrimination panel; we will ask folks who weren't selected for other committees if they would like to be put forward for this committee
