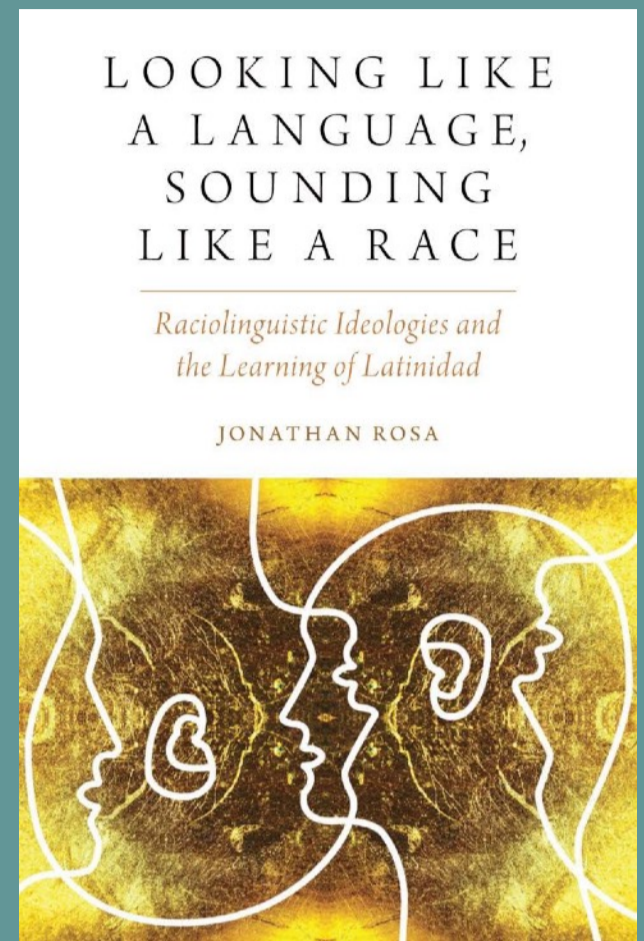


Looking like Language, Sounding Like Race

The Colorado College Department of Anthropology invites you to our first lecture event of the fall semester with guest lecturer Professor Jonathan Rosa. Rosa's lecture will draw from ethnographic and sociolinguistic fieldwork in a Chicago public school whose student body is primarily Latinx to analyze the racialization of language and its relationship to issues of power and national identity. The lecture will be followed by a Q&A session.



Speaker Bio:

Jonathan Rosa is an Assistant Professor of Education and Linguistics at Stanford University. His book, *Looking Like Language, Sounding Like Race: Raciolinguistic Ideologies and the learning of Latinad*, analyzes the racialization of language in relation to power and national identity. Within the context of la Latinidad it examines the emergence of ethnoracial and linguistic categories.
