

## Music Minor:

To complete the music minor, students must complete a dedicated set of three "Music Foundations" courses that establish core music literacies used to think and create music broadly in the context of the liberal arts. Additionally, students will complete 3 units of "Electives" to explore further into specialized areas, sparking and enhancing intellectual and creative curiosity.

Music minors are required to attend at least 4 concerts each semester. Declared minors in good standing will receive private music lesson scholarships for 1 set of departmental lessons each semester.

To declare a music minor, a student must have taken at least one academic music course OR one full unit of lessons and/or ensembles (four .25 units).

### Music Foundations (3 units):

These three courses provide a foundation for the major/minor, establishing music literacy across the ways we think about music in the context of the liberal arts. They are designed to provide an overview of the approaches we take in the department and introduce areas that students may wish to explore further. Students should complete these courses early in their progress towards the major.

- MU203: Listening to Music
- MU204: Writing About Music
- MU205: Decoding Music

### Music Electives (3 units):

Electives within the music minor give students the ability to explore broadly or in a focused way, even possibly highlighting intersections with a student's primary field of study. Our range of elective offerings also allows flexibility for students to be meaningfully and flexibly engaged with the department.

- 1 unit of lessons/ensembles (comprised of four .25-units)
- 1 unit of block-long coursework
- 1 additional unit (block-long course, two half-blocks, or four .25 units of lessons/ensemble)
