From Jennifer DeDominici:

The 25th Annual Putnam County Spelling Bee is, in many ways, a simple show. There is no turntable, no pyrotechnics, no cast of thousands. It does not require elaborate sets or costumes. Simplicity in these ways is attractive when producing a show in Packard Concert Hall which is shared by all the groups in the Music Department, and which is not equipped like a traditional theater.

Simplicity also allows us to tell the stories of these characters by focusing on the power of words, music, and movement. We can laugh, groan, and cry as we watch humans navigate through new social situations, personal relationships, and growing pains without the need of much more than our talented actors and their commitment to the story.

I love that this story creates a communal safe space for people who otherwise feel unsafe, alone, or "other" in their lives. Through the experience of the spelling bee and the love of words, these humans find a new way to understand their world, themselves, and each other.

We hear many definitions and uses of words in sentences throughout this show. I love most of all that, by the end of the show, we are left pondering the alternate definitions of "winning."
