Prior Psychology Major Requirements (2012–2021)

Overview

A minimum of 12 courses and 13 blocks are required to complete the major – Ten (10) courses from within the Psychology Department and two (2) courses from outside the department. These courses are listed below.

7) ONE Science Competency Course:	Any Non-Psychology Natural Sciences Division Course

Grading Requirements

A grade of C-minus or better is required for all courses used to fulfill either set of major requirements. If a lower grade was received for a required course, the course must be repeated. Grades of D, D+, or CR may count toward graduation requirements but NOT toward major requirements.
