Creating a CSS Profile Account for Parent Use

To complete a CSS Profile, you need to have a College Board *student* account. This can be confusing when you need to complete the CSS Profile as a *parent* (for example, as a noncustodial parent). Below are important tips and instructions to help you create an account as a parent.

Important Tips

- * Create the account using your (the parent's) information, not the student's
- * On the "Getting Started" screen of the CSS Profile, update the pre-filled information (name & email address) to the student's information

Creating an Account

- 1. Go to https://cssprofile.collegeboard.org/
- Click Sign In to Apply in the header of the page

- Select the application award year (e.g. Sign In 2018-19)
- 4. Click Sign Up
- 5. Complete the form *using your (the parent's) information, not your student's information.*

- 2. Click Sign In to Apply in the header of the page
- 3. Select the application award year
- 4. Sign in using the account you created
