In order to expedite the processing of this appeal, it is recommended you provide supporting documentation with your appeal form. Documentation examples include:

- Submission of a court order or official Federal or State documentation that the student's parents or legal guardian are incarcerated.
- Written statement from
  - o A state, county, or Tribal welfare agency;
  - o an independent living case worker who supports current and former foster youth with the transition to adulthood:
  - a public or private agency, facility, or program servicing the victims of abuse, neglect, assault, or violence
  - o guardian ad litem or court-appointed special advocate (or similar) that confirms the circumstances and their relationship to the student
- Written statement from a representative at an institution of higher education that confirms the circumstances and their relationship to the student

If further documentation is required upon review of the appeal, the email addresses provided will be utilized as the means of communication with the appellant. Students are responsible for responding to such emails within 10 days with all requested documentation or this appeal will be closed.
