

MAT Licensure Program Costs for the 2021-22 Academic Year

Tuition – Fall 2021	\$18,000
Tuition – Spring 2022	\$12,300
Tuition – Summer 2022	\$ 4,000
Total COA	\$34,300

A Financial Aid Award will combine loans and any grant funds awarded to fund the MAT Licensure program.

- As a graduate student you may borrow up to \$20,500 in Federal Unsubsidized Stafford loans during an academic year (fall, spring, summer).
- When you are deciding on the amount to borrow, be aware that all students enrolled at CC must have health insurance. If you are not already covered, you may be required to purchase health insurance. The charge for the 21-22 academic year is \$2817
- The breakdown of the following budgets for Fall 2021, Spring 2022, and Summer 2022 semesters may help
 determine an amount you want to borrow for your expenses.
