In what state did Frederick return home to and become the first African-American elected to the state legislature? 4. CC purchased the Spencer Center building in 1991. What was the previous name of the building? – *Answer: The Gaslight Plaza Building (will accept Plaza Building or Plaza Hotel)*
5. Six of CC's buildings are on the national register of historic places. What two residential halls are amongst the six? *Answer: Bemis and Montgomery*
6. CC has been an integral part of the two Century Chest ceremonies for Colorado Springs. The latest chest was closed up in April 2001. A Native American letter written by a CC student was one of the seventeen items included by the college. What tribe was represented in the letter? Multiple Choice: Apache, Arapaho, Comanche, Navajo, Pueblo or Ute - *Answer: Navajo*
