Self-Identification for Individuals with Disabilities

Although self-identification is voluntary, students and employees are encouraged to notify the college of any assistance they may need in the event of an emergency. Students requesting assistance in planning for their needs during an emergency should meet with Accessibility Resources and employees with Human Resources. Campus Safety will be informed of pertinent information regarding an individual's needs for assistance during an emergency. Campus Safety will provide emergency responders with the information on record regarding the needs and location of individuals with disabilities. Please note, though, that an individual's immediate location will not always be known by Campus Safety.
