National Public Lands Helps the Colorado Economy


A mere 3% say it hurts; 17% say it has little impact.

Oppose State Takeover of Public Lands

"Some Members of Congress have proposed giving Colorado state government control over national public lands, such as national forests, national monuments, and national wildlife refuges in its borders. The state government would decide the future management of the lands, but state taxpayers would pay all costs, including the cost of maintenance and preventing and fighting wildfires."
