

Four hundred and sixteen (416) graduates with an outcome have accepted:






EMPLOYMENT

CAREERS BY SECTOR




Number of Graduates in Career Sector

OUTCOMES

There were 524 Graduates in the Class of 2023. Data for 486 graduates (*a knowledge rate of 92.7%*) of the Class of 2023 was collected. This includes those who graduated between July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2023. Of those 486, **85.6% were employed, continuing education, in the military, or participating in a fellowship or service commitment within six months of graduation**.

Knowledge rate refers to the percentage of graduates for whom information of their first destination career outcomes has been obtained. This includes survey data reported by graduates, LinkedIn profile information, and knowledge shared by reliable sources.
