## Core Requirements

- Apply to the CES program
- Complete 1 program orientation session
- Log 300 hours of engagement over your time in the program
- Attend 8 CCE Changemaker Workshops
- Attend 1 campus event or talk per year in the program that connects to issues you are passionate about
- Attend the CCE Senior Symposium
- Apply to graduate with CES distinction.

## Community Engaged Learning Concentration

In addition to the above requirements, students can choose to complete the following, beginning their junior year, to earn the \*Community Engaged Learning Concentration

- Attend 4 junior capstone focused Changemaker workshops
- Attend 4 senior capstone focused Changemaker workshops
- Submit a capstone proposal (Block 7 junior year)
- Submit reflections on 3 classes in Summit
- Present your capstone at the CCE Senior Symposium
