

Children's Center Illness and Exclusion

Guidelines for illness exclusion will differ from our typical exclusions, per Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) and the recommendation of Child Health Connection, our nursing consultant company.

Children/staff with the following symptoms will be excluded from care/work for at least 72 hours after fevers or exclusionary symptoms have resolved without the use of fever reducers/cough medicines. This list highlights additions to our illness/exclusion guidelines and may change without advance notice.

- Temperatures of 100 degrees and above (no other symptoms necessary)
- Temperatures of 99 degrees with any respiratory symptoms such as cough, shortness of breath, or complaint of chest hurting
- Temperatures of 99 degrees with fatigue or the inability to participate

If anyone in your household is waiting to be tested for COVID-19, awaiting results, or self-quarantining, your child will need to be excluded from care for up to 14 days. Please speak to Danielle for clarification or to notify us of any testing/self-quarantine.

Please keep your children home if they are ill. Any children who are excluded because of illness while at the center will be removed from the classroom while awaiting pick-up.
