

Student Award, Scholarship and Fellowship Payment Form

<u>SECTION 1</u> The definition of a student award is any payment that is intended to reward the student for an educational accomplishment or provide them with financial assistance to pursue an educational goal. Educational awards include the following types of payments: tuition and fees, room and board, travel, research, supplies and equipment, books, computers, student health insurance and medical expenses.

Please Note: Awards to students that are educational in nature are generally considered scholarships and / or fellowships by the IRS and may be considered taxable income to the recipient. The awards will be reported on either IRS Form 1098-T or IRS Form 1042-S if the award is made to an international student. If an award is not educational in nature it will be reported on Form 1099-MISC or Form 1042-S for an international student. An example of a non-educational award would be a prize from a contest.
