

Prospective Exchange Students

EXCHANGE STUDENT PROCESS

- 1. Apply to Colorado College's exchange program via your home school's international office.
- 2. Your home school nominates you to Colorado College by submitting your Nomination form.
- 3. After your nomination is accepted, you will receive an email from Colorado College with further instructions to complete the application.
- 4. Complete the application before the deadline date.

REQUIRED MATERIALS

Once you have been nominated, you will receive instructions via email about completing the application. The following application materials will be required:

- Incoming exchange application form
- Official transcript (must be in English)
- Financial support documentation
 - o Must be in English
 - Must provide evidence of funds sufficient to cover the duration of your exchange program
- Copy of your passport biographical page
- Official TOEFL/IELTS scores (or alternate verification of English Language Proficiency)

All materials must be in English except the passport biographical page. All materials must be submitted by the deadlines below.

Application Deadline (materials received from student)	
Fall Term (August – December)	May 31 st
Spring Term (January – May)	October 15 th

We will not issue your exchange visitor visa paperwork until we have received a completed application from you. Submit your application and all supporting documentation to:
