

HOW TO APPLY FOR A SUMMER BLOCK ABROAD



1 LEARN!

- Learn as much about the program as you can!
 - Speak with the faculty leader(s) of the program.
 - Come to the Summer Away Fair in early November and review the program info on the Global Education website.

2 APPLY!

- Apply to the program on SUMMIT during the summer application period.
- The summer application period is from Block 3 through Block J in January. Check the website for deadline date.

3 LATE APPLICATION IS RISKY!

- Application is for both program and aid consideration!
 - You will be notified of your aid award soon after you are notified of your acceptance to a program.
 - Late application is risky! Rosters may fill during the main application period.
 - Aid is limited and may be gone if you apply after the application period ends.
- Late applications will not be accepted past the last day of BLOCK 7!

4 CONFIRMATION

- Complete key confirmation documents
Students are typically alerted of their application status within 2 weeks of the deadline for summer applications.

Once accepted to the program, there will be more documents to complete on Summit - these must be completed BEFORE you enroll on Banner. Course COI will be provided when you complete the documents.

5 ENROLLMENT

- Enroll in Banner during Pre-Registration
 - When you receive the course code, you can enroll on Banner.
 - Enrollment must be completed by **February 14!**

6 CONGRATULATIONS!

- You are in the program, now what?
 - Retain your GPA above 2.00 to remain eligible.
 - Avoid disciplinary probations or suspensions.
 - Expect and respond to faculty leader emails!
 - Attend all pre-departure orientation meetings.
