

# HOW TO APPLY FOR A SUMMER BLOCK ABROAD



## 1 LEARN!

- Learn as much about the program as you can!
  - Attend the block away fair on **October 31st**.
  - Speak with the faculty leader(s) of the program.
  - Review the program info on the Global Education website.

## 2 APPLY!

- Apply to the program on SUMMIT during the summer application period.
  - The summer application period is **October 31-December 2nd**.

## 3 LATE APPLICATION IS RISKY!

- Application is for both program and aid consideration!
  - You will be notified of your aid award when you are notified of your acceptance to a program.
  - Late application is risky! Rosters may fill during the app period.
  - Aid is limited and may be gone if you apply after the app period ends.
- Late applications will not be accepted past the last day of **BLOCK 7!**

## 4 CONFIRMATION

- Complete key confirmation documents
  - All students will know their acceptance status by the first day of Winter Break.
  - Once accepted to the program, there will be more documents to complete on Summit - these are due by **January 15!**
  - Only upon completion will a Banner course code be provided to you.

## 5 ENROLLMENT

- Enroll in Banner during Pre-Registration
  - When you receive the course code, you can enroll on Banner.
  - Enrollment must be completed by **February 4!**

## 6 CONGRATULATIONS!

- You are in the program, now what?
  - Retain your GPA above 2.00 to remain eligible.
  - Avoid disciplinary probations or suspensions.
  - Expect and respond to faculty leader emails!
  - Attend all pre-departure orientation meetings.
