AN OPENING NOTE ABOUT VISAS

- It is **always** important to research what documentation *you specifically* will need to secure for any plans you make overseas, as well as what process you will need to follow, to obtain legal immigration/permission for all of these options we will discuss today.
- Many programs, graduate schools, and partners overseas sponsor you through this process – this is **VERY** valuable assistance. You may wish to prioritize groups or organizations that can help you with this process.
- Colorado College cannot issue visa documentation and support letters for most overseas opportunities (only if you are taking part in a CC-led program).

External preparation: TEFL/CELTA opportunities

- Consider a Teaching English as a Foreign Language (TEFL) certificate through a LEGIT program
 - (one that has in-classroom experiences and teaching practicum are best)
- CELTA= Certificate in English Language Teaching to Adults
- Volunteer opportunities with local school districts

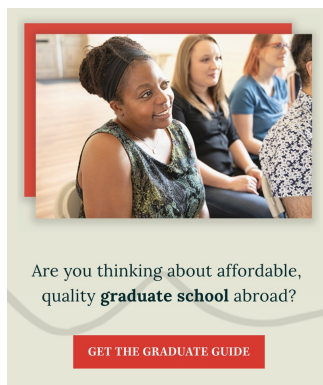
