The Office of Institutional Planning and Effectiveness at Colorado College compiled information on postgraduate residence, career activities, and educational pursuits of the class of 2018. To create a profile that was as representative of the graduating class as possible, data was gathered from a variety of resources including the National Student Clearinghouse, LinkedIn, and other social media profiles. These resources combined provided some information on 92.4% of the entire class (483 of 526), as of the summer of 2023.


- 26% were found to be living Colorado
