VWP – Visa Waiver Program: The VWP enables citizens of <u>participating countries</u> to travel to the U.S. for business/tourism (for 90 days or less) without obtaining a U.S. visa. Persons eligible to enter the U.S. on the visa waiver program do not require visas and do not have to visit the U.S. Consulate or Embassy. However, they do need to get pre-authorization using the <u>Electronic System for Travel Authorization</u> (ESTA).
