# Emerging Themes for the Bemis School of Art Subcommittee October 18, 2016

## Unique opportunity to <u>build bridges</u>.

- Connections need to be made between:
  - the CS community and CC students
  - FAC staff to CC students/faculty
  - CC and other institutions, including non-profits and other art organizations locally, nationally and globally
- Bridges could lead to possible careers for CC students
- **Reciprocity** happens in bridge building, during a generative exchanges of ideas, resources, and expertise.
  - o CC touches community and Community touches CC

#### Build an Incubator Space

- Serve as a place for the **PROCESS of creativity** and creation
- Interactions for learning and exploring
  - o Part of Innovation
- Laboratory/sandbox for teaching AND learning.
- Bemis should prioritize experiential learning and the value of creating art over the academic/collegiate study of the arts as a discipline.
- o Emphasizes divergent thinking
- Vibrant, alive, well utilized
- Fluidity of space
- Inspired by local/national/global communities, projects grow OUT to reach local/national/global communities
- Overlaps with work that one has to do anyway, thus can be part of one's job instead of "in addition to"
- Safe spaces where mistakes/errors are seen as part of the process
  - where all ages, demographics and levels of education learn together and from one another

#### Inventive Stewardship

- CC students and community members of all ages should be attracted to wealth of classes available, hooked into the family that emerges from co-creation, and nurtured in the process of the arts being a shared human experience.
- Connections made to wellness, health, work so that people see the arts as value added
- Better outreach and more accessibility for PreK-12 education and exploration of the process of arts creation
- STEM becomes STEAM
- FAC as more <u>ACCESSIBLE</u> in a variety of ways: physically, socio-economically, and through more diversity to attract all residents of Colorado Springs.
- **Community museum** local artist displays from all ages, service to community

- Utilized by all of El Paso County and up into Monument/Woodland Park...
- More interactive ways to experience learning in a museum, theater and school
- o Clear educational interactions between museum, Bemis and theater

### Arts Advocacy

- Seeing the arts as integral universal human need; ALL arts are a critical part of our being.
- FAC@CC should champion the arts in our city of champions.
- We should create awareness and visibility, so that our entire community is aware of the possible ways to interact with the FAC@CC
- Better publicity/communication/visibility in ways that reach different demographics of audiences and contributors.

## Institution as Oasis

- Emphasizing the co-curricular in balance with the academic
- Bemis plays a critical role in creating places which nurture the understanding that art and community are basic human needs
- o Relevant to a variety of audiences and art forms
- With leadership provided by a wide demographic group of people
- Accessible to all no matter level of education

## Space for Learning

- Desire to maintain ease of access to Bemis for community members by maintaining a single location with proximity to the museum, that also serves as an entry point for Bemis users to then feel comfortable navigating the broader CC campus
- Expanded space that increases
  - $\circ \quad \mbox{access for a wide range of demographics}$
  - number of options in learning across a variety of art forms (from dance/theater to additional arts/crafts and new digital technologies)
  - $\circ$   $\,$  CC's ability to look outward  $\,$
  - Utilization of space for various community and CC groups that are not specific to the arts
- **Experiential**, **two way learning** between CC students, community students, FAC staff, CC staff, faculty and guests
