- Teach, live, and work with campers ages 6-16 at camps ranging from half-day to week long residential experiences. This includes teaching from a lesson plan, lesson plan creation, and program assessment creation and implementation- with guidance from the Education Director
- Lead on and off-camp trips, activities, programs and special events. This may include driving a 15 passenger van, hiking over rugged terrain, and being comfortable camping in wilderness settings
- Responsibility for shared cooking and cleaning duties for camp overnights and student supervision at meals
- Flexibility in response to current and emergency situations and to shifts in camp responsibilities
- Demonstrate increased knowledge and leadership by fulfilling the camp director role for a camp at the end of the summer
