Who is eligible

- All degree-seeking registered students or students on an approved study abroad program are automatically enrolled in this insurance plan, unless proof of comparable coverage is furnished.
- The student (named insured, as defined in the certificate) must actively attend classes for at least the first 31 days of the semester period for which coverage is purchased. Home study, correspondence, and online courses do not fulfill the eligibility requirements that the student actively attend classes. The carrier maintains its right to investigate eligibility or student status and attendance records to verify that the policy eligibility requirements have been met. If and whenever the carrier discovers that the policy eligibility requirements have not been met, its only obligation is refund of premium, less any claims paid.
- Students withdrawing after such 31 days will remain covered under the policy for the term purchased and no refund will be allowed.
