- IV. Committee Updates:
 - Outreach:

 - Student life:

- VI. Presentation of the Future Plans for Worner by Amy:
 - o Basements:
 - Mailroom becomes the food pantry/swap space and could be home to book exchange. We could do a lot there. No renovation needed. Collab by student activities and sustainability
 - Mailbox area— would become a creative space you could book— Arts and crafts, etc
 - Bookstore: its fire capacity is pretty small there will be no walls built in this space. I think a stage, table tennis, pool tables, etc. Could be a chill and flexible area. But also tables and whiteboards so clubs could book the space as well
 - Student organizations would have priority of the space
 - Book store office similar to CCSGA office— study space meeting room
 - Other storage for CCSGA, student life
 - Wall in the back was a bookable mural wall that clubs could book
 - We want all these spaces to be flexible
 - o First floor:
 - Coburn returning to arts and crafts
 - 2nd floor furniture moved down to first floor because it's prettier

Second floor:

- WRC— flex student life/event space that would give priority to multicultural organizations. If not booked, it could be booked by other groups
- Spaces that are offices would become small group study spaces
- Looking to turn some rooms into prayer and mediation rooms
