- Mike Edmonds: Yes, in the sense that we are hearing people's requests to make it online. Trying to figure out how to best accommodate students who need campus as their home and making it as safe as we possibly can. There are certainly also people who say bring everyone back and let the chips fall
- Elliott: On the topic of cohort living-- have we thought of having every person who wants to is able to take one in-person class. Half of the student body comes back and then it switches
- Mike Edmonds: Absolutely, there are committees looking into that. Everything on the table. Please bring that up in the trustee meeting and give a student perspective.
- Mike Edmonds: You guys bring up a good point. You have a lot of people working on multiple plans, at what point do we zero in on a plan. I would love you guys to think about that and get back to me.
- Sakina: if we want to continue this, we can vote on our things or set up another day.
- Mike Edmonds: I think I would like Bryan and Claire to come to join us.
