ACCESSIBILITY

RESTRICTED / PRIVATE AREAS OF CAMPUS

Alumni are welcome to explore campus and reminisce about their college days. However, please respect that your old dorm room is now the private room of a current student. In addition, due to current COVID restrictions, we ask that visitors for Homecoming and Family Weekend not enter any student residence buildings during your time on campus. And remember, you are expected to follow all current campus COVID-19 protocols which includes wearing a mask indoors at all times regardless of vaccination status.

COVID REQUIREMENTS

All attendees of the Colorado College 2021 Homecoming and Family Weekend are required to abide by CC's Public Events policy. This includes submitting proof of vaccination, a negative COVID-19 test result from within 72 hours of check-in, or proof of infection and recovery from COVID-19 (at least 10 days prior with no symptoms, and no more than 90 days prior to event). A valid photo ID will be required along with presentation of one of these forms of COVID documentation at Registration Central. Your Homecoming and Family Weekend nametag will be your proof of compliance, and will be required to enter any event on campus. (Current students may present their active gold card.)

All attendees are also required to follow the current CC risk mitigation protocols, **which include wearing a mask indoors at all times**, except when actively eating or drinking.

Please note that all activities are subject to COVID-19 guidelines and the schedule is subject to change. The health and safety of our CC alumni, students, families, faculty, and staff community continues to be our top priority. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding as we work to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 both on the CC campus and in the greater Colorado Springs community.

CHILD CARE

No child care will be provided during the Homecoming and Family Weekend, but children are welcome to attend with their parents. Children age 12 and younger eat for free at all on-campus events.

CC BOOKSTORE

The Colorado College Bookstore has moved! It is now located in the Yalich Student Services Center adjacent to Ed Robson Arena. The bookstore offers a 21% discount on one CC logo item to anyone who is registered and wearing an official Homecoming and Family Weekend nametag.

PARKING

During Homecoming and Family Weekend, **all campus parking lots are closed**. Limited street parking is available and is part of the City of Colorado Springs Parking System. Please pay parking fees and obey all city parking regulations when parking on city streets. CC has also reserved free parking at two downtown locations. You may park and walk (less than one mile to campus from each) or ride the free CC shuttle from these locations during the following times:

Self-pay parking is also available all weekend in the city parking garage at the corner of Bijou St. and Cascade Ave. (directly across from the Hilton Garden Inn). You may pay to park here and ride the free CC shuttle. Limited ADA/accessible parking is available on campus. If you requested ADA parking in advance, please check with registration central when you arrive. Oversized vehicles, such as RVs, cannot be accommodated in any campus parking lots. Please see the following information about shuttles which are available from the downtown area during Homecoming and Family Weekend.

SHUTTLE SERVICE

A complimentary Colorado College shuttle will be available during Homecoming and Family Weekend to transport parents, families, alumni, and their guests between campus and the downtown area. The on-campus shuttle drop-off and pick-up location is Worner Campus Center (south doors off Cache La Poudre). The shuttle will run twice per hour between campus and the following locations:

- The main entrance of the Antlers Hotel
- The main entrance of the Mining Exchange Hotel
- On Cascade Ave. just outside the city parking garage located at the NE corner of Bijou St. and Cascade Ave. This will also serve as the pick-up location for the Hilton Garden Inn.
- Young Life Administration parking lot (420 N. Cascade Ave.)
- School District 11 Administration and North Junior High parking lots (1115 N. El Paso Street)

Local rideshare services as well as a bike rental program (pikeride.org) are also available throughout the downtown Colorado Springs area.
