### ENVIRONMENT AT THE BALLOT BOX




**87%** of Montanans say that issues involving clean water, wildlife, and public lands are important in deciding whether to support an elected public official.

#### ENERGY ON PUBLIC LANDS

95% support requiring oil and gas companies to pay for all clean-up and restoration costs after drilling.

# RECREATION



**73%** think that oil and gas development on national public lands should be stopped or strictly limited, as opposed to expanded.

### PROTECTING LAND, WATER & WILDLIFE



**71%** support a national goal of protecting 30 percent of America's lands and waters by 2030.



**73%** support creating new national parks, national monuments, national wildlife refuges, and tribal protected areas.

# **FIRE & DROUGHT CONCERNS**

92% are concerned about more frequent and severe wildfires.

74% think that wildfires in the West are more of a problem than they were 10 years ago.

86% are concerned about droughts and reduced snowpack.

## **ACTION ON CLIMATE CHANGE**

**59%** support gradually transitioning to one hundred percent clean, renewable energy over the next ten to fifteen years.

**58%** say that there is enough evidence of climate change that action should be taken.
