
ENVIRONMENT AT THE BALLOT BOX



85% of Utahns say that issues involving clean water, wildlife, and public lands are important in deciding whether to support an elected public official.




ENERGY ON PUBLIC LANDS





64% support a national goal of protecting 30 percent of America's lands and waters by 2030.
