63% consider themselves to be conservationists.

support presidents continuing to use their ability to protect existing public lands as national monuments.

WATER & DROUGHT CONCERNS

86% describe the current shortage of water supplies in the West as a problem.

83% support requiring local governments to determine whether there is enough water available before approving new residential development projects.

82% support providing financial incentives to homeowners and businesses to replace lawns and grassy areas with water-saving landscaping.

ENERGY ON PUBLIC LANDS

74% support only allowing oil and gas companies the right to drill in areas where there is high likelihood to actually produce oil and gas.

prefer that leaders place more emphasis on protecting water, air, wildlife habitat and recreation opportunities over maximizing the amount of land available for drilling and mining.

support requiring oil and gas companies, rather than federal and state governments, to pay for all of the clean-up and land restoration costs after drilling is finished.
