

Conservation Efforts Important to Fund – Extremely/Very Important

- 87% Managing forests to help prevent catastrophic wildfires
- 83% Protecting and restoring the health of rivers, lakes and streams
- 80% Conserving land corridors which wildlife like deer and elk use for migration
- 78% Conserving sensitive areas which the state has identified as crucial wildlife habitat

67% of Latinos say it would be a bad change to remove national monument protections from lands in the West which contain archeological and Native American sites

49% say it would be a bad change to reduce the amount of time that the public can comment on proposed changes affecting public lands
