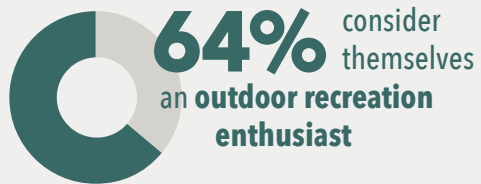
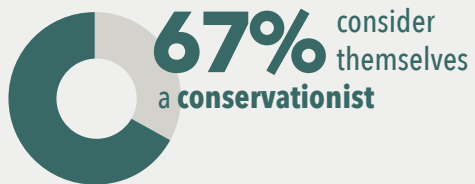

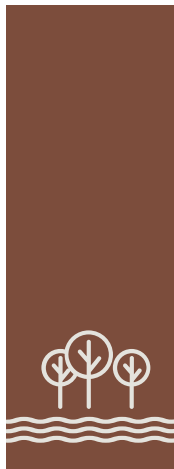
A CONSERVATION MINDSET

THE OUTDOOR RECREATION ECONOMY



53% say the ability to live near, recreate on, and enjoy public lands like national forests, parks, or trails was a **significant reason they live in the West**



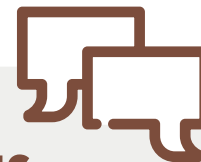
84% believe the **outdoor recreation economy is important** for the future of their state and the Western U.S.

PROTECTING LAND, WATER, AND WILDLIFE

82% believe it is important for states to use funds to **protect and restore the health of rivers, lakes, and streams**

73% believe it is important for states to use funds to **conserve wildlife corridors** used by wildlife for migration

PUBLIC INPUT INTO PUBLIC LAND DECISIONS



17% think it was a good decision to **reduce the amount of time the public can comment** on changes to public lands, such as oil and gas leasing

55% think it was a **bad decision**
