### THE OUTDOOR RECREATION **ECONOMY**



53% say the ability to live near, recreate on, and enjoy public lands like national forests, parks, or trails was a significant reason they live in the West



believe the outdoor recreation economy is important for the future of their state and the Western U.S.

### PROTECTING LAND, WATER, **AND WILDLIFE**

**82%** believe it is important for states to use funds to **protect and restore the health** of rivers, lakes, and streams

73% believe it is important for states to use funds to conserve wildlife cooridors used by wildlife for migration

## **PUBLIC INPUT INTO**

think it was a good decision to reduce the amount of time the public can comment on changes to public lands, such as oil and gas leasing

55% think it was a bad decision
