


#### WOULD YOU PREFER THE NEW CONGRESS PLACE MORE EMPHASIS ON...


...protecting sources of clean water, our air quality and wildlife habitat while providing opportunities to visit and recreate on our national public lands



## THE IMPACT OF WILDFIRE



**68%** think wildfires in the West are more of a problem than ten years ago

# THE OUTDOOR RECREATION ECONOMY



**75%** say the ability to live near, recreate on, and enjoy public lands like national forests, parks, or trails was a significant reason they live in the West



**90%** believe the **outdoor recreation economy is important** for the future of their state and the Western U.S.

### PROTECTING LAND, WATER, AND WILDLIFE

**76%** believe it is important for states to use funds to protect and restore the health of rivers, lakes, and streams

61% believe it is important for states to use funds to conserve wildlife cooridors used by wildlife for migration
