

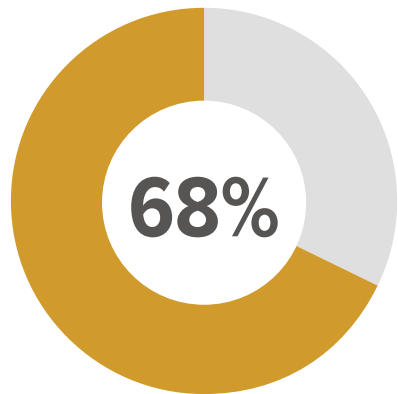

22% Ensuring we produce more domestic energy by maximizing the amount of national public lands available for responsible oil and gas drilling and mining

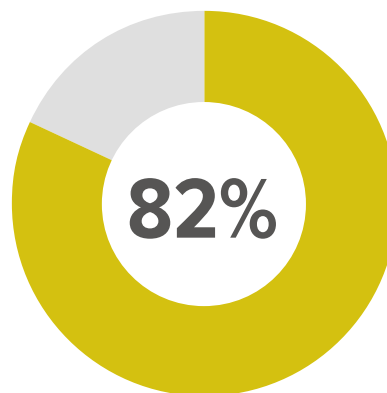
46% of Idahoans disapprove of the way the Trump administration is handling issues related to land, water and wildlife. 46% approve.

Idaho's outdoor recreation economy

94% of Idahoans think the outdoor recreation economy — meaning people who come to hunt, fish, camp, see wildlife, as well as those who manufacture and sell equipment for those activities — is **important to the economic future of the state**.

80% of Idahoans think the presence of public lands and a lifestyle of outdoor recreation gives the West an **economic advantage over other parts of the country**.
