

96% of Montanans think the outdoor recreation economy — meaning people who come to hunt, fish, camp, see wildlife, as well as those who manufacture and sell equipment for those activities — is important to the economic future of the state.

76% Montanans think the presence of public lands and a lifestyle of outdoor recreation gives the West an **economic advantage over other parts of the country.**
