

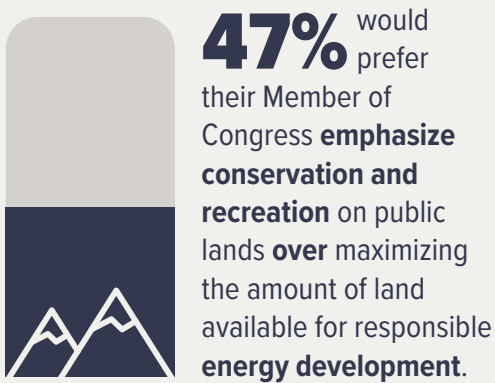

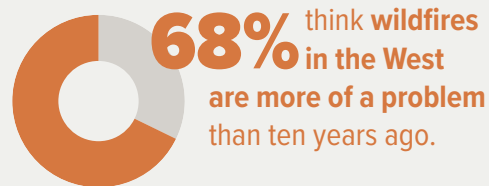

FIRE IN THE WEST



PROTECTING LAND, WATER & WILDLIFE



58% support a national goal of **protecting 30 percent** of America's lands and oceans by 2030.



65% support **creating new national parks, national monuments, national wildlife refuges, and tribal protected areas.**

CONSERVATION FUNDING

89% agree that even with state budget problems, we should still find money to protect the state's land, water, and wildlife.

68% support **directing funding to ensure adequate access to parks and natural areas** for lower-income people and communities of color that have disproportionately lacked them.

ACTION ON CLIMATE CHANGE

47% support **gradually transitioning to one hundred percent clean, renewable energy** over the next ten to fifteen years.

53% support making **public lands a net-zero source of carbon pollution.**
