Mail date: May 2025

Once your introductory text is received the CC Alumni Office will send out to classmates via MAIL and EMAIL.

Committee role: draft **introductory text** (1-2 paragraphs) inviting classmates to the reunion. The text should invoke nostalgia and remind classmates why they should come back for the reunion.

CC Staff role: will fill in your final event details, committee roster, website information, etc.
